What is Live-In Care?

Live-in care is a cost-effective alternative to residential care that allows you to maintain independence and control at home. It offers people the opportunity to build a closer relationship with one carer and to receive around-the-clock support from a trained professional that knows your routines as well as you do. Once you get in touch with us and tell us a little bit more about the level of care you or your loved one require, we'll put together an initial assessment and give you some idea of what level of support we think you'll need and how much it might cost.

From there, we'll sit down with you for a face-to-face chat and we'll get to know you and your circumstances a little better. We'll use these initial conversations with you to build a profile of the kind of live-in carer that suits you and your family. We'll then present you with a few options and together we'll choose a live-in carer based on their experience, qualifications, character, and skills.





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Who is Live-In Care for?

Clarendon Live-in care is for people who wish to remain living at home independently while also having the safety and reassurance of round-the-clock care from a fully trained professional. The service is designed to be as flexible as you want it to be, meaning that you might have a close friendship with your carer or you may just want them to be on hand at the specific times you need help the most.

Live-in care allows people that use the service to stay in control of their life, keep up with their hobbies, interests, and routines and to maintain relationships with their family, friends, neighbours and their wider community. We provide live-in care for adults of all ages across Surrey and South West London. We look after people with many different health conditions, each of whom require

very specific skills and often innovative ways to meet their needs.

Whether it's specialist dementia care you're looking for or perhaps some support to prevent a loved one from becoming isolated, Clarendon Live-in Care will help you to first compile the right care plan and then find the ideal carer to suit you. Live-in care for couples

How does home care work?

We've been providing award-winning home care since 1994. With our Home Care service, a fully-trained care assistant will come to your door each day and provide you or your loved one with the support you require, based on the personalised care plan we'll draw up together.

We'll discuss your care needs with you or your loved one and from there we'll design a care plan that includes a timetable of visiting care. Some people might have a visit once or twice a week while people with more complex care needs might require up to four visits a day. Visits can last anywhere from fifteen minutes up to three hours so the care is flexible too. You'll be able to tell us when you can manage certain tasks and when you want us to assist you.





Who is home care for?

Our fully-regulated visiting Home Care service is for anybody that wants to go on living independently at home but who needs a little extra help around the house.

It could be that somebody needs temporary support following a hospital stay or it might be that they require help managing a long-term condition like Parkinson's.

Visiting carers often become a lifeline for those that are feeling isolated or alone. It's hard to put a value on the effect that a friendly face at the door can have on your day, especially when you're feeling low or like you can't manage in the same way you used to.
